 This petition is filed to challenge the order Annexure P.17 dated 19.08.2013 by which notice of auction of the land of the petitioner was given as well.

 In the reply filed by the Deputy Commissioner, he has disowned the said document (Annexure P.17) alleging that “the present petition has been filed by the petitioners by challenging the impugned notice dated 19.08.2013 allegedly issued by respondent No.2 to the extent of inclusion of land of the petitioner fixing the same for auction for leasing out the same, but no such order was ever passed by the respondent no.2 and as such the present petition is nothing, but an abuse of process of law.”

 Since the Deputy Commissioner, Ferozepur is not owning the document (Annexure P.17), therefore, the anxiety of the petitioner is misconceived and hence, the present petition is disposed of as such.
