Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus, certiorari or any other appropriate writ quashing the inaction of the official respondents for not complying with provisions of Punjab State Cooperative Agricultural Service Society Service Rules, 1997 as well as for not considering the complaints dated 27.05.2017 (Annexure P-3), 07.06.2017 (Annexure P-4) and 17.06.2017 (Annexure P-5) against the private respondents whereby prayer has been made by the petitioners for releasing the due benefits i.e. gratuity, leave encashment and appointment.

The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that though a legal notice dated June 19, 2017 (Annexure P-6) was issued to The Registrar of the Cooperative Agricultural Society, Punjab, but till date no action has been taken by respondents No.2 & 3 i.e. Deputy Registrar, Cooperative Agricultural Society and Assistant Registrar, Cooperative Agricultural Society, Patiala.

Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice dated June 19, 2016 (Annexure P-6) and take a decision within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

However, if the petitioners still feel aggrieved by an order passed by any of the authorities, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
