Learned counsel for respondent Nos.1 to 4 has produced the copy of office order dated 22.12.2016 vide which the petitioner-Department has decided to appoint private respondents as direct employees along with minimum of the basic pay. The order has been passed unconditionally and is not subject to the outcome of this writ petition. It further appears from the tone and tenor of the order that the authorities have taken a conscious decision to grant the said relief in the light of the earlier orders of the Tribunal and of this Court, which have been upheld by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

2. In this view of the matter, the writ petition appears to have been rendered infructuous and is disposed of, accordingly.

3. However, liberty is granted to the writ petitioners to seek its revival, if need be.
