JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the daily wage services followed by regular service of the petitioner, and to release revised retiral benefits with interest @ 18% per annum from the date of his retirement till its actual payment as per rules and instructions.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 27.04.2017 (Annexure P-5) within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in his representation dated 27.04.2017 (Annexure P-5) and to decide the same, strictly in accordance with instructions dated 07.02.2014 (Annexure P-2)

No.4/51/2013-2Pension dated 07.02.2014 as well as circular bearing Memo No.CH-218/GM/Admn./Gen165 dated 16.01.2014 (whereby the instructions/Memo No.577/LB-21 (Misc) Part IV dated 17.12.2013 were brought to the notice of concerned authorities for complying with the same) as well as judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court passed in *Civil Appeal No.1772 of 2009* titled as *State of Haryana and others Vs. Sh. Kesho Ram* decided on 10.12.2009, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
