Petitioner has preferred this writ petition seeking a direction to the police not to act on frivolous report dated 18.10.2016, whereby name of the petitioner has figured. According to him, entire exercise is in order to malign the petitioner and to implicate him in a false case. He has also prayed that life and liberty of the petitioner be protected.

On the last date of hearing, a copy of the petition was handed over to the State counsel in order to enable him to assist the court. According to him, Inspector Harish Behl, Economic Offences Wing, Amritsar, a member of the Special Investigation Team is present in court. He submits that numerous complaints have been received regarding functioning of Dara Future Vision, Amritsar. Same are being investigated and statements of 115 persons have been recorded. Petitioner has not been called by the investigating agency so far. Besides, police does not perceive any threat to his life and liberty, who has been a Municipal Councillor earlier.

On due consideration of the matter, I find no ground to interfere. It is inexplicable why petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this court. The petition is not only vague but prayer made therein is not clear. It appears, number of objections were raised by the registry as well while entertaining the petition. However, on insistence of the counsel, the case was listed before this bench. It appears, the entire petition is nothing but misuse of process of law. Filing of such frivolous petitions needs to be discouraged. Under the circumstances, same is dismissed with Rs.50,000/- as costs, to be deposited with Legal Services Authority, Punjab, which shall be at liberty to remit the same to an established Institution for destitute children.
