The petitioner has claimed that the monetary benefits in view of death of her husband be released. The facts are that the husband of the petitioner was dismissed on being convicted in a case under the Prevention of Corruption Act. An appeal against that conviction is pending.

Counsel for the petitioner is not in a position to dispute that till such time as that conviction stands, the dues being now claimed cannot be released.

In these circumstances, this writ petition is dismissed at this stage as pre-mature.
