1. In the instant writ petition, petitioner has questioned the selection and appointment of 4th respondent to the post of PGT (Hindi) on the ground that petitioner is more merited than the 4th respondent if 1+1 marks are awarded to the petitioner for the purpose of possessing of NCC Certificate for Grade B and C.

2. Learned State counsel was directed to produce original record relating to application form of the petitioner and its enclosures.

3. Perusal of application and its enclosures, it is evident that petitioner has produced only NCC Grade 'C' Certificate. Accordingly, the selecting authority have awarded one mark as per the criteria. In the absence of production of NCC Grade 'B' Certificate by the petitioner along with application form, he is not entitled for one additional mark as per the

criteria. Thus, the respondents have rightly rejected the petitioner's claim for non-production of NCC Grade 'B' Certificate to claim one more mark and so also claiming merit over and above the 4th respondent.

4. Hence, instant writ petition stands dismissed.
