Perusal of the affidavit dated 26.04.2017 it is evident that official respondents have not initiated departmental inquiry by framing charge or petitioner was facing criminal case and he has not been charge-sheeted as on the date of juniors promotion to the post of TGT (Science). Therefore, the official respondents are directed to consider the petitioner's name for promotion to the post of TGT (Science) w.e.f. 22.03.2016 if the petitioner is otherwise eligible.

With the above observation, petition stands disposed of.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is entitled for consequential benefits on promotion to the post of TGT (Science) w.e.f. 22.03.2016. The same shall be extended to the petitioner within a period of two months from today.
