The prayer in the present case is for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of Assured Career Progression Scheme (ACP) on completion of 4/9/14 years of service along with arrears with interest @ 18% per annum. The said benefits have not been released to the petitioners in spite of making representation and sending the legal notice on 01.05.2017, which is annexed as Annexure P-4 with the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case directions are issued to the respondents to consider the legal notice dated 01.05.2017 (Annexure P-4) within some stipulated period.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioners and without commenting on the merits of the case, present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider the legal notice dated 01.05.2017 (Annexure P-4) and to take action within a period of three months from the date of receipt of copy of the order. In case the petitioners are found to be entitled for the benefits, the same be granted to them within a period of two months thereafter. In case any adverse view is to be taken, then a detailed speaking order be passed.

In case the petitioners are aggrieved by the order, they are at liberty to avail alternative remedy.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
