Challenge in the instant petition is to the order dated 08.09.2016 (Annexure P-5), passed by the Assistant Manager/H.R., Central Operation Zone, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, Ludhiana and in terms of which, the services of the petitioner while working on the post of Foreman have been terminated.

On a specific query having been raised, counsel would concede that under the Punjab State Electricity Board (Now P.S.P.C.L.) Punishment and Appeal Regulations 1971, petitioner has the statutory remedy of filing an appeal against the order of termination.

Confronted with such a situation, counsel prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to avail of the statutory

remedy available to the petitioner under the regulations governing his service conditions.

Prayer is allowed.

Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
