Prayer in the present writ petition is for issuance of writ of mandamus, certiorari or any other direction for setting aside the orders dated 09.09.2015 (Annexure P-4) whereby permission granted to the petitioner for exhibition of his film titled "The Master Mind Jindha Sukha" (Punjabi), was revoked vide orders dated 23.07.2015.

There is remedy of appeal under Section 5 of Cinematograph Act, 1952 available to challenge the impugned order dated 09.09.2015.

At this stage, learned counsel seeks liberty of this Court to avail the remedy of filing appeal, provided the period spent herein be condoned.

In case aforementioned liberty is availed within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of order, period spent herein shall deem to have been condoned.

With the aforementioned observations, present writ petition stands disposed of.
