JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release all the pending retiral/service dues of the petitioner with interest.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a legal notice dated January 18, 2017 (Annexure P-4) was served upon the respondents but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents No.2 and 4 to consider and decide the legal notice dated January 18, 2017 (Annexure P-4) within a stipulated period.

Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 4 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated January 18, 2017 (Annexure P-4) and to decide the same

within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
