By this petition the petitioner is claiming second mercy chance to clear two subjects of BAMS 3rd Professional Examination.

As per the ordinance of the University (Annexure P-4), admittedly only one mercy chance can be granted by the Vice-Chancellor in the entire BAMS Course. This has been availed of by the petitioner in BAMS Ist Professional Examination.

Learned counsel has argued that the petitioner is a handicapped student.

Be that as it may, the Court can not allow a relief which is expressly barred by the law.

Consequently, the petition is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
