The controversy involved in the present case is with regard to filling up the post of Lambardar in village Chanian, Tehsil Nakodar, District Jalandhar. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the petitioner has expired, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous. However, a direction is issued to the Collector to initiate the process of filling up the post of Lambardar in the aforementioned village. In case the process of appointment is initiated, respondent No. 2 would be at liberty to apply for the said post.
