JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the gratuity, GPF, leave encashment and other pensionary benefits with interest upto date, for the service rendered by the petitioner in the Respondent-Department which has not been released by the respondents till today.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the application dated 21.03.2017 (Annexure P-2) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in application dated 21.03.2017 (Annexure P-2) and take a decision within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In

case, the concerned authority comes to the conclusion that petitioner is entitled to the benefits claimed by him, the same be disbursed to him within a period of two months thereafter.
