JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought for issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to release the pension and pensionary benefits w.e.f. the date of his superannuation along with all consequential benefits, in terms of rules governing the conditions of service and in view of the fact that the Regulations of Board dated 20.07.2005 (Annexure P-1) vide which, it has been accepted that all Rules and Regulations etc. of the employee of State of Punjab would be applicable to the employees of respondent-Corporation.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondent to decide legal notice dated 04.07.2016 (Annexure P-14) within a stipulated period.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the respondent to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice dated 04.07.2016 (Annexure P-14) and take a decision within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
