By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the retiral dues including gratuity (Rs.10,00,000/- and leave encashment (Rs.6,43,106/-) along with interest @ 18% p.a. w.e.f. 01.02.2016 as the petitioner superannuated on 31.01.2016 unconditionally since no departmental proceedings were pending or contemplated on the eve of his retirement. Further prayer is to grant interest @ 18% p.a. on delayed payment of GPF.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondent(s) to decide representation dated 21.06.2017 (Annexure P-6) within a stipulated period.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 21.06.2017 (Annexure P-6) and to decide the same, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
