By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ of certiorari quashing the order dated June 02, 2017 (Annexure P-15) to the extent it imposes New Defined Contributory Pension Scheme in pursuance to circular dated December 12, 2006 (Annexure P-3) in an illegal, arbitrary and coercive manner against the law laid down by this Court vide judgment dated August 31, 2010 (Annexure P-8), which has been upheld by Hon'ble Apex Court on July 30, 2012 (Annexure P-9) and recently followed in CWP No. 17294 of 2015 decided on February 19, 2016 (Annexure P-12)

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that that though after April 25, 2017 some proceedings have been initiated for the

grant of relief but the same has not been finalized so far and in this regard a representation dated April 25, 2017 (Annexure P-5) was moved to respondent No.5 but till date no action has been taken on the said representation. She further submits that she feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.5 to dispose of the representation (Annexure P-5) within a stipulate period.

Accordingly, Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.5 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated April 25, 2017 (Annexure P-5) and to decide the same particularly in view of the judgment passed by a Division Bench of this Court in CWP No. 2371 of 2010 titled as **Harbans Lal vs. State of Punjab and others**, decided on August 31, 2010 (***Annexure P-8***), which has been upheld by Hon'ble Apex Court vide (***Annexure P-9***) as also the pronouncement of this Court in the case of **Sharanjot Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**; CWP No. ***17294 of 2015, decided on February 19, 2016 (Annexure P-12)***, within a period of three months from the date of certified copy of this order.

However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
