Through instant petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing the part of order dated 11.08.2003 (Annexure P-3) and revisional order dated 04.04.2005 (Annexure P-5). Further, for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent to decide the statutory review petition dated 24.05.2005 (Annexure P-7) filed under Regulation 32 of the Punjab State Electricity Board Employees Punishment and Appeal Regulations, 1971 in compliance of order dated 10.05.2005 passed by this Court in CWP No.7328 of 2015, which has not been decided till date.

2. The contention of learned counsel for the petitioner is that though

review petition under Regulation 32 of the Punjab State Electricity Board Employees Punishment and Appeal Regulations, 1971, against order dated 04.04.2005, passed by Punjab State Electricity Board, Patiala, under regulation 29 of the aforesaid regulation, in compliance of order passed in CWP No.7328 of 2005, is pending before the Chairman-cum-Managing Director, Punjab State Electricity Board, Patiala, Punjab (now Punjab State Power Corporation), but has not been dealt with and disposed of by the concerned authorities. Even, a legal notice was also served upon the respondent on 06.10.2016 (Annexure P-8) but no response has been received so far.

3. Taking into consideration the aforesaid aspect of the case, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to Chairman-cum-Managing Director, Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd., Patiala, to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his review petition (Annexure P-7) and take conscious decision in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
