SURYA KANT, J. (Oral)

(1) This order shall dispose of CWP Nos.1565, 1573 & 1574 of 2017 as the point in issue is common.

(2) Learned senior counsel submits that the Tribunal has turned down the claim of the petitioner(s) on an erroneous premise that their involvement in the criminal case was not the foundation of the order of their discharge from service. However, the information taken under the RTI subsequent to the order of the Tribunal reveals that the petitioner(s) was actually discharged only because he was implicated in the criminal case in which he was subsequently acquitted. Learned senior counsel thus seeks to withdraw the writ petition(s) so as to file review application(s) before the Tribunal.

(3) With liberty afore-mentioned, the writ petitions are dismissed as withdrawn.

(4) Ordered accordingly.
