Through instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant 3rd Assured Career Progression (ACP) to petitioners No. 1 to 3 which is due since 2005 and 2nd ACP to petitioner No.4 as the same is due since 2006 along with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though legal notice dated 07.04.2017 (Annexure P-7) was duly served upon the respondents, but till date no action has been taken by them.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated

07.04.2017 (Annexure P-7) and decide the same particularly in view of the judgments passed by this Court in CWP No.10051 of 2013, titled as ***“Prithvi Singh v. State of Haryana and others”*** decided on 27.04.2016 (Annexure P-5) and CWP No.23074 of 2010, titled as ***“Ram Pal Patwari and others v. State of Haryana and another,*** decided on 24.07.2015 (Annexure P-6) within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
