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**DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.**

The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to declare the result of the petitioner and to provide original mark sheet and degree of B.Ed to her.

The present petition has been filed without approaching the respondent-authorities and no representation has been placed on record .

Since the petitioner has approached this Court without making any representation or approaching the respondent-authorities, no direction can be issued and accordingly the present writ petition is dismissed as premature.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the respondent-authorities for his grievance by moving a representation. In case such representation is moved by the petitioner within a period of one month from today, the respondents are directed to consider the same within a period of one month thereafter.
