This petition is filed against the order of the Permanent Lok Adalat dated 5.1.2016 by which an application filed under Section 22 of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 filed by the petitioner has been dismissed.

Counsel for the U.T. Chandigarh has submitted at the outset that the order passed by the Administration is appealable in terms of clause 17 of The Chandigarh Small Flats Scheme 2006 (as amended scheme of 2009).

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of this petition with liberty to file the appeal. However, he has prayed that the limitation to file the appeal may be condoned.

After taking into consideration the facts and

circumstances of the case, the petitioner is permitted to withdraw this petition in order to file the appeal. It is made clear that if the appeal is filed within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, then the question of limitation shall not be raised by the appellate authority.
