JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 and 2 to release all retiral dues including gratuity and leave encashment with interest @ 18% p.a. from the date of its accrual till its actual realization.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents No.1 and 2 to decide the legal notice dated 21.07.2017 (Annexure P-7) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice dated 21.07.2017 (Annexure P-7) and take a decision within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order including the grant of interest on the delayed

payment. In case, the concerned authority comes to the conclusion that petitioner is entitled to the benefits claimed by him, the same be disbursed to him within a period of two months thereafter.
