Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner and grant family pension under the Scheme of Punjab Government vide letter No.1/1/2000-3 F.P.P. and coordination branch dated 22.12.2006 has issued instructions and have allowed family Pension to the deceased employees of the Tubewell Circle of Irrigation Branch and permanently merged in the Corporation to draw family Pension subject to the condition that family pensioners shall not draw any family pension under the provision of the Family Pension Act, 1971 and with also obtain a certificate from Regional Provident Fund Commissioner.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondent(s) to decide the letter dated 14.12.2015 (Annexure P-5) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in letter dated 14.12.2015 (Annexure P-5) and take a decision within a period of three months as per Rules of the Government dated 22.12.2006, from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
