JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to fix and implement the amended scale of employee/petitioner as Tractor Operator cadre who was transferred from Irrigation Department Punjab Government to Electricity Board since 01.04.1998 w.e.f. 01.01.1996 as per Circular No.25/2003 dated 13.11.2003 (Annexure P-5) and then release all the retiral benefits connected with the post of petitioner along with interest calculated from the date of transfer.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents No.1 and 2 to consider representations dated 19.10.2016 (Annexures P-10), (Annexure P-11) and decide the same in accordance with law particularly in view Instructions/Circular of Finance Department (Annexure P-5) though number of representations were made by the petitioner to the respondents including representations (Annexures P-10 and P-11) but till date no relief has been granted.

Instant petition is disposed of with direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to consider the claim of the petitioner in his representations (Annexures P-10 and P-11) in accordance with law and rules particularly in view of Finance Circular No.25/2003, Punjab State Electricity Board (P.R.C. Section), Patiala, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
