This petition is filed by the Sarpanch. The Gram Panchayat comprises of five Panches and a Sarpanch. The petitioner has prayed that directions may be issued to the respondents not to appoint the Administrator to execute the work of the Gram Panchayat.

During the course of hearing, it is submitted that as per the information of the petitioner, respondent No.5 has been appointed as an Administrator but the petitioner is not in possession of any such order. This Court can only exercise jurisdiction of judicial review in case any order is passed. Therefore, the present petition is hereby disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to apply for the copy of the order passed by BDPO, appointing respondent No.5 as Administrator. If the application is filed within a period of three days from today, the copy of the order be given to the petitioner within three days thereafter positively.

Copy of the order be given dasti to counsel for the petitioner on payment of usual charges.
