The petitioners have approached this court claiming that acquisition of land in question has lapsed in view of Section 24(2) of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (for short, 'the 2013 Act'). Notifications under Sections 4 and 6 of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 were issued on 30.11.2006 and 28.11.2007, respectively.

As the award in the present case was announced by the Land

Acquisition Collector on 26.11.2009 and till the enactment of the 2013 Act on 1.1.2014, five years had not lapsed, no claim can be made under Section 24(2) of the 2013 Act.

Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed.
