By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release pension benefits and the interest to the petitioners on the delayed payment of pensionary benefits in terms of statutory rules, Govt. instructions and law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in *R.S. Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab*, 1997(3) RSJ 318.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though a legal notice dated 05.10.2016 (Annexure P-3) was served upon the respondents and period of more than nine months have elapsed but no decision has been taken till date.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to official respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated 05.10.2016 (Annexure P-3) particularly in view of

judgment passed by the Hon'ble Appellate Court in case of *R.S. Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab*, 1997(3) RSJ 318 as well as in *Satpal Singh and others Vs. Pepsu Road Transport Corporation, Patiala and another* in CWP No.10331 of 2016 decided on 23.07.2016 and to decide the same within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
