The petitioner seeks quashing of the show cause notice dated 07.05.2010 (Annexure P-10) issued to him, whereby departmental proceedings were sought to be proceeded ahead. The respondent No.3 had issued show cause notice for dismissal of service, keeping in view the charge of mis-conduct leveled against the petitioner, which had been proved in the departmental inquiry.

The petitioner had approached this Court only on the ground that he would be prejudiced since criminal proceedings were also pending against him in FIR No.486 dated 17.09.2009 before the Court at Kurukshetra. This Court vide notice of motion order dated 20.05.2010 had granted the benefit of protection and restrained the respondents from initiating any action, till further orders.

Counsel for the State has placed on record photocopy of the order passed by the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kurukshetra dated 16.04.2015, whereby the petitioner has been given the benefit of doubt and acquittal has been recorded.

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Resultantly, the criminal proceedings having been terminated, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly, with liberty to the respondents to proceed ahead in accordance with law.
