Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought for issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide notice dated 2nd June, 2017 and grant the pay and another emoluments for the period on the petitioners were on sanctioned medical leave along with interest in terms of law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in *R.S. Randhawa Vs. State of Punjab*, 1997(3) RSJ 318.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondent(s) to decide legal notice dated 02.06.2017 (Annexure P-1) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the official respondent(s) to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in legal notice dated 02.06.2017 (Annexure P-1) and take a decision within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
