By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing of impugned order dated 19/20.09.2016 (Annexure P-15) whereby the claim of the petitioner for promotion to the post of Accountant/Senior Assistant against the roster point of backlog vacancy under SC category has been rejected by respondent No.1 illegally, arbitrarily and in unjustified manner since it is against the factual and legal position.
