By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of full pension after rendering minimum qualifying service of 25 years to the petitioners as granted to their counterparts working in the Government Schools, in view of instructions (Annexures P-6 and P-7) issued by the Government from time to time.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to official respondent(s) to decide representations dated 30.05.2017 (Annexures P-8 and P-9) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to official respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representations dated 30.05.2017 (Annexures P-8 and P-9) and to decide the same in accordance with law in the light of instructions dated 15.12.2011 and 13.06.2012 (Annexures P-6 and P-7), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
