Petitioner is an S.S. Mistress serving under the Punjab State Education Department.

She is currently serving at Govt. Senior Secondary School, Mattewal, district Amritsar.

The prayer made in the instant petition is for issuance of directions to the respondent authorities/employer to adjust her and to give her a different place of posting.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

Decisions with regard to issuance of transfer/posting order are best left to the judgement of the employer. No provision has been referred to by the counsel on the basis of which any substantive right accrues to the petitioner so as to entitle her to invoke the extra ordinary jurisdiction of this Court seeking transfer and adjustment to any other place.

As such, while declining to interfere in the instant petition, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the respondent authorities/competent authority as regards her claim and grievance.
