Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that though this petition has presently been rendered infructuous with respondent no. 3 now having been removed from the post in question, it being a 'writ of quo-warranto', challenging the action of respondents no. 1 and 2 for having appointed respondent no. 3, as a General Manager, he further submits that earlier also the petitioner had filed CWP No. 11790 of 2014, challenging the appointment of one Mahipal Singh, also on the same post as was last held by respondent no. 3, (i.e. General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Engineering Corporation), on the ground that the said person also did not possess the basic eligibility qualification.

Upon that writ petition having been filed, within three days the aforesaid Mahipal Singh was removed by respondents no. 1 and 2 from the post, as has been done now in the case of respondent no. 3.

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Consequently, while disposing of this petition as having been rendered infructuous, respondents no. 1 and 2 are directed to ensure that any person appointed to the post in question, would only be after duly seeing that he/she fulfills the basic eligibility conditions for the post.
