The petitioner has prayed for extension of license to run a tea/catering stall No.14 at Platform No. 4/5, Railway Station, Ludhiana.

It is submitted that the petitioner has entered into an agreement with the Railways on 28.8.2009. It was later on extended from 28.9.2014 to 27.9.2017. It is submitted that the said contract is going to expire, therefore, the petitioner has approached this Court for seeking a direction for the purpose of extension of contract/license. During the course of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly conceded that the petitioner has not, so far, approached the competent authority, with a prayer for extension of his license/contract.

He has further submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the writ petition to make an application to the concerned authority for the purpose of extension of license.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of

with liberty to first approach the concerned authority for the purpose of seeking extension of license and in case, it is not granted the petitioner is at liberty to approach this Court, if so advised.
