By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the Provident Fund, Gratuity, leave-encashment, arrears of Dearness Allowance and other due retiral benefits with interest @ 12% per annum.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that representation dated June 30, 2017 (Annexure P-2) has been served upon the respondents for the necessary relief but no action is being taken and she would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the said representation within a specified period.

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3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to take a decision on her representation dated June 30, 2017 (Annexure P-2) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, any amount found due the same be released immediately.

4. However, if petitioner still feel aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
