By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the pension and other pensionary benefits to the petitioner along with interest and further directing the respondents to release the revocation of suspension treating suspension period as duty period.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that representation dated June 10, 2017 (Annexure P-3) has been served upon the respondents for the necessary relief but no action is being taken and he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to

consider and decide the said representation within a specified period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on his representation dated June 10, 2017 (Annexure P-3) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feel aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
