By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to issue all service benefits to the petitioner after death of her husband on November 18, 2016 during service; further petitioner may be given service whichever is suitable to the petitioner after the death of her husband on the post of Lab-Assistant and deciding her representation dated March 17, 2017 (Annexure P-8).

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that representation dated March 17, 2017 (Annexure P-8) has been served upon the respondents for the necessary relief but no action is being taken

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and he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the said representation within a specified period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on her representation dated March 17, 2017 (Annexure P-8) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feel aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
