By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner and release the medical reimbursement claim of ₹ 1,75,000/- to the petitioner to which he is entitled under cashless Punjab Government Employees and Pensioners Health Insurance Scheme (PGEHIS) issued vide notification dated October 20, 2015 (Annexure P-2) along with interest from the date it became due.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that representation dated March 02, 2017 (Annexure P-8) has been served

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upon the respondents for the necessary relief but no action is being taken and he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.4-Insurance Company to consider and decide the said representation within a specified period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.4-Oriental Insurance Company Ltd. to take a decision on his representation dated March 02, 2017 (Annexure P-8) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feel aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
