In the instant writ petition, the petitioner has questioned the validity of the order dated 7.11.2003 (Annexure P-4) by which his claim for compassionate appointment has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner's father retired from service on medical ground on 31.3.2003. He submitted an application for compassionate appointment (medical ground) in the month of September-October 2003. The petitioner's application was rejected on 7.11.2003.

The cause of action accrued for the petitioner in the year 2003-04 whereas the petitioner has questioned the validity of the order dated 7.11.2003 only in the year 2011. Purpose of claiming compassionate appointment on medical ground is to meet the harness in the family when the bread earner passed away or retired on medical ground. In the present case, the petitioner's father retired on medical ground on 31.3.2003. From 2003 to 2011, the petitioner's family has no difficulty as is evident from the fact that the petitioner has approached this Court in the year 2011.

Therefore, on the ground of delay and laches on the part of the petitioner, the petition stands dismissed.
