(1) The petitioners are residents of village Kalkha, Tehsil Matlauda, District Panipat. The Gram Panchayat of their village has resolved to lease out one of the pond (johar) for fishing purposes. The petitioners allege that the resolution is detrimental to the interest of the residents as they will not be able to feed water to their domestic cattle and will also not be permitted to utilize the pond. The petitioners have already made a complaint-cum-representation to the District Administration on 17.01.2017 but without awaiting any action thereupon, they have rushed to this Court. In this view of the matter and without expressing any views on the petitioner's allegations, the Deputy Commissioner, Panipat is directed to look into the petitioners' complaint and if need be, issue necessary instructions to the Gram Panchayat so that the residents of the village are not deprived of the facilities of the village pond.

(2) It shall be appreciated if appropriate action is taken within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

(3) Disposed of accordingly.
