JASPAL SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought for issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the daily-wages service of the petitioner from December, 1982 to 31.03.1993 towards qualifying service for the purpose of pension and other retiral benefits and accordingly, release the same with effect from the date of retirement of the petitioner with arrears and penal interest @ 18% per annum.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents No.5 and 6 to decide the legal notice dated 30.11.2016 (Annexure P-4) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondents No.5 and 6 to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice dated 30.11.2016 (Annexure P-4) and take a decision within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
