The instant writ petition has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to grant 3 marks to petitioners No.1 and 4 marks to petitioners No.2 to 5, in view of the decision taken by the Expert Committee that had been constituted by this court in LPA No.1064 of 2015.

Learned counsel for the respondents-State has filed the counter-affidavit of Director, SCERT, Punjab, which is taken on record and a copy thereof has been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners. In the reply, it is submitted that result of the petitioners stands revised and the revised result has been declared on 20.01.2017.

In view of the fact that necessary relief has been granted to the petitioners, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the instant writ petition.

Accordingly, the instant writ petition stands dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
