Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought for issuance of a writ, order directing the respondents to discharge their statutory liability by releasing the full Contributory Provident Fund (CPF along with arrears from due date till the service tenure of petitioners as per statutory rates prescribed by the affiliating university calendar in due compliance to the judgment/undertaking dated 06.07.2010 passed in bunch of writ petitions including main CWP No.76 of 2006 and further upheld and affirmed in LPA by the Division Bench vide judgment dated 05.04.2011 and further directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court vide orders dated 26.11.2013 to pay the CPF by the managements/colleges.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to official respondent(s) to decide the legal notice dated 18.02.2017 (Annexure P-7) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to official respondent(s) to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in legal notice dated 18.02.2017 (Annexure P-7) particularly in view of judgments dated 06.07.2010, 05.04.2011 and 26.11.2013 (Annexures P-1 to P-3) as well as latest order dated 08.02.2017 (Annexure P-10) i.e. the judgment passed in CWP No.2355 of 2017 decided on 08.02.2017 captioned as *Dr. Bharat Bhushan and others Vs. State of Punjab and others* and take a decision within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and in case, the concerned authority comes to the conclusion that petitioners are entitled to the benefits claimed by them, the same be released/disbursed to them within next two months.
