The petitioner is aggrieved of the resolution Agenda Nos.4 and 8. The same was agitated before the Deputy Registrar Cooperative Society. By accepting the case of the petitioners, the then Managing Committee was dissolved. The aforementioned order assailed by the opposite side was also dismissed by the Additional Registrar Cooperative Society vide order dated 04.11.2010. However, in revision taken before the Secretary, same has been allowed and the impugned orders have been set aside.

Mr. A.P.S. Shergill, Advocate for petitioners submits that necessary corollary of the aforementioned order does not restore back the Managing Committee as period of Managing Committee was over in 2012

itself. However, he has been left remediless with regard to the alleged cuttings and manipulations in the agenda.

At the best, petitioners could have sought indulgence of the authorities for taking an appropriate action in those proceedings, but having failed to do so, in my view, present writ petition has become infructuous as elections of the Managing Committee as informed by Mr. Vikas Singh, Advocate was held on 10th March 2012 and that period of Managing Committee is also over on 9th of March, 2012.

Accordingly, present writ petition stands infructuous.
