JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to remove anomaly in the pay of the petitioner by fixing the same at par with his colleague Sh. Sukhminder Singh (Asst. Engineer) from the due date, when anomaly arose and to give him all the consequential benefits of revision of pay and revised pensionary benefits and the consequent arrears thereof along with interest thereon @ 12% p.a.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to the official respondents to decide the legal notice dated 01.05.2017 (Annexure P-3) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with the direction to the official respondent(s) to consider the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in legal notice dated 01.05.2017 (Annexure P-3) and take a decision within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the concerned authority comes to the conclusion that petitioner is entitled to the benefits claimed by him, the same be released/disbursed to him within next two months.
