Learned counsel for the petitioner states that a notice dated 31st March, 2017 (Annexure P-6) was issued under Section 148 of the Income Tax Act, 1961 (in short 'the Act'), which has been replied by the petitioner by filing objections vide letter dated 04th July, 2017 (Annexure P-8).

2. It was not disputed that on Annexure P-8, no order has been passed so far.
