Learned Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal has passed the impugned clarificatory order dated 18.07.2017 to the effect that there is no interim stay operative after 18.02.2016. The main appeal has been fixed for hearing on 04.08.2017. The bank has neither taken any step so far nor appears to be inclined to take over the management of the Institutes being run by the petitioner-Society.

The instant writ petition is accordingly disposed of with a request to the learned Tribunal to make an endeavour to hear the main case on 04.08.2017.

Let management of the Institutes being run by the petitioner-Society be not taken over by the Bank till 04.08.2017. This interim order shall not be operative beyond 04.08.2017.
