By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the pension/retiral benefits, gratuity, leave encashment, arrears of ACP and first, second and third ACP by counting the services of the petitioners rendered with the HSMITC.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a legal notice dated May 22, 2017 (Annexure P-1) was served upon the respondents but neither any reply has been received nor any conscious decision has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in the

legal notice dated May 22, 2017(Annexure P-1) and take a conscious decision in accordance with law, rules and regulation and instructions issued from time to time and also keeping in view the judgment dated July 28, 2015 passed in CWP No. 6493 of 2012, titled as **Ram Kumar vs. State of Haryana and others,** (Annexure P-2) and judgment dated February 18, 2009 passed in CWP No. 14121 of 20107 titled as **Ishwar Singh vs. State of Haryana and others,** within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioners still feel aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
